

# STORMWATER RUNOFF is NOT TREATED



Stormwater runoff discharges directly into waterbodies. Illicit items such as trash, oil, debris, pet waste, paints, leaves/grass, and other pollutants are prohibited and can cause issues downstream.

## DO YOUR PART TO HELP YOUR COMMUNITY

- **Dispose used automotive fluids and batteries at drop-off locations (don't pour into inlets)**
- **Pick up pet waste and properly dispose**
- **Drain your pool or spa (chlorine or salt) to the sanitary sewer system (verify local Ordinances/Rate Orders)**
- **Bag grass and yard debris (don't blow or sweep into the street or inlet)**
- **Don't rinse paint brushes or paint cans outside**
- **Report illegal dumping to the phone number below**
